

Calliope: "Once I was... A lot bigger than this. I shone with a light so bright it lit up every corner of the galaxy.


And now I am this. As your Wonder has faded, so have I. I must open your eyes wide again."




Girl: "My eyes *are* open. There is just nothing to look at anymore.






Polyhymnia: "Calliope! Didn't you tell the poor girl anything?"

Euterpe: "We guide you and help you and you give us strength. We are here to remind you of who you are."




Page 25:


Page 26: Girl: "I don't dance anymore. All my things are packed away."


Terpsichore: "You sure can dance! Pop some much on and just, like, feel the beat."


Page 29:

Euterpe: "Hanging out with your friends always made you happy, right? Going out shoppin', or for food or staying in and watching a film."




Page 30:

Girl: "They probably hate me now... I haven't even been on their social media. I can't do it. I haven't spoken to them in a while. They are so perfect. I'm just... Not."




Page 31:

I will never let anyone hurt her. Ever.


Girl: "That feels like a promise I won't be able to keep."

Girl: "I grew up. I'm an adult."


Thalis: "So? There is nothin' wrong with pretendin'! Even readin' your old notebook, that'll be fun."



Terpsichore: "Please, calm down! You'll tip the boat!"


Girl: No no no NO why did you do that? I-I thought that maybe I could be better. But now I know it is impossible."

Girl: AAAAHHHHHHH!






Melpomene: "Hello."




Page 47: Melpomene: "Oh... it's time for me to go. I'll see you soon."


Girl: "Oh. This is still a dream. I'm exhausted."

Girl: "Existing is too hard. I hurt the wisps that were trying to help me. I'm a failure. I don't deserve to be here."


Urania: "You aren't a failure. You're a human being. You have as much of a right to be here as anyone else."



Page 50:



Girl: "But what if it isn't?"




Page 51:


Page 53:

Girl: "I'm sorry. I'm sorry, I don't know why I'm crying."


Urania: "There is no need to apologise for showing your emotions, for telling people how you feel. Humans support each other. Can you hear that?"

Page 54:


